4. Funding and Support Opportunities

- a. The <u>UK Space Agency Accelerator's Explore programme</u> is open for applications until **31st May**. Explore is a 9-week accelerator sprint to support budding Space entrepreneurs to transform their ideas into solid foundations for a scalable business. Successful applicants will work with a panel of experts and join a vibrant community of fellow Space entrepreneurs.
- b. Innovate UK's <u>New Innovators in communications networks 2024</u> programme is open for applications until 12th June 2024. UK-registered micro and small businesses can apply for a share of up to £500,000 to develop adoptable and investable innovations within communication networks.
- c. European Space Agency's <u>Commercial Applications of Space-Enabled Robotics: Transport and Logistics</u> programme is inviting proposals for services that combine the use of satellite technologies and robotics for downstream services for transport and logistics. The deadline for this call is **26**th **June**.
